

# **DRAFT - KTSA Range Rental Fees & Policies for the Calendar Year 2006**

(updated June 15, 2006)

## **Responsibility & Liability:**

- The KTSA will not be liable for any injury or damage to persons or personal property resulting from the range rentals.
- Any group renting KTSA ranges do so at their own risk.
- Renters will be responsible for all damage caused to KTSA property.

## **Rates for the Indoor Range:**

- Provincial/National Sport Organizations: \$50/day plus \$2/person.
- All other organizations and Government agencies: \$200/day plus \$2/person.
- Club members for business purposes: \$10/day/person.

## **Rates for the Outdoor Ranges (Long and Short):**

- Provincial/National Sport Organizations: \$50/day plus \$2/person.
- All other organizations and Government agencies: \$200/day plus \$2/person.
- Club members for business purposes: \$100/day plus \$2/person.

## **Policies Related to Bookings & Fees:**

1. One day of rental is 8:00 am to 5:00 pm (or part thereof).
2. Booking will entitle the user to exclusive use of the range for the period of time specified at time of booking.
3. Bookings must be done with at least 30 days advance notice. If 30 days advance notice is not given, a 50% surcharge will be assessed.
4. A deposit of 50% of the fee will be collected (non refundable) at the time of booking. The remainder must be paid within 30 days after the booked date.
5. A damage deposit of one-half the day rate is required at time of booking. Damage resulting from users will be repaired by the KTSA and invoices submitted to the user for re-imbusement. If the range is left in a dirty condition, the KTSA will clean the range and invoice the user. The damage deposit will be returned if no damage occur and if cleaning is not required.

**Policies Related to Activity at the Range:**

1. The KTSA will inspect the range prior to use.
2. Users will notify the KTSA when complete and the range is ready for inspection.
3. Rental does not include target frames. KTSA will provide target frames for \$150/day.
4. Users will post signs at the entrance gate to the outdoor range or at the entrance door at the indoor range that the range is in use. Signs will be removed upon leaving.
5. Users will follow the rules as posted at the ranges.
6. Users will leave the range tidy and clean each day manner (i.e., doors closed, gates locked, brass cleaned up, garbage removed, etc.).
7. Danger flags or lights must be used at all times while on the range.
8. If KTSA members arrive and wish to use the range, politely direct them to the range that is not in use.
9. Ensure range doors and gates are closed when you leave.
10. Ensure tables and chairs are stacked neatly in the corner of the range building.
11. Open fires are not allowed at any of the outdoor ranges.
12. Do not leave wood stoves at the outdoor ranges unattended and extinguish fires prior to leaving.
