Membership – Stefan Schweiser.

- In 2018 we had a 13.76% Membership increase (net 199 more members, 1645 vs 1446 the year before). From those 199 a 155 have been renewing members and 44 brand new members. Our year over year increase in memberships for the past 4-5 years is in the 9-12% range per year.
- Single Family memberships grew 20%, Family Memberships 12%, Senior Memberships 5.9%, Sr. Family and Junior memberships stayed unchanged, and we had an increase in Handicapped memberships of 42% (in absolute numbers 6 more, 20 instead of 14). Life Membership renewals stayed unchanged at 12, no new Life Memberships have been issued in 2018. We have 23 Life Memberships issued to date.
- Our female membership grew in 2018 the same percentage as our male membership. Although lower in absolute numbers they stay at 19.5% of our overall memberships that is up from 17.8% in 2015.
- About 89% of our members are from Kamloops the rest from surrounding Kamloops and within the province and 3 out of province.
